## PUERTO RICO BOARD OF PSICOLOGISTS

### PUBLIC HEARING

In accordance with the powers and faculties conferred by Act No. 81 of March 14, 1912, Act No. 11 of June 23, 1976, Act No. 96 of June 4, 1983, as amended, and Act No. 38 of June 30, 2017, the Secretary of Health intends to adopt the new *General Regulations of the Puerto Rico Board of Examiners of Psychologists, as well as the Code of Ethics and Professional Conduct, Standards for services through Telepsychology and Procedure for Disciplinary Matters of the Exercise of the Profession of Psychology in Puerto Rico*. Both the Regulations and the proposed Code of Ethics are intended to establish the general requirements for the practice of Psychology in Puerto Rico and the ethical canons applicable to this profession.
